

RETURNED SOLDIER KILLED.

Wounded in Flanders. Had Lately
Come From England—Hit by Auto.

Windsor, Dec. 21.—Private Charles R. Lemmon of Sandwich, who was severely wounded in Flanders, was picked up unconscious on Woodbine avenue, Detroit, early this morning, and died a short time later in the hospital. The police came to the conclusion he had been struck by an auto. He had only recently returned from a hospital in England, where he underwent an operation and had a silver plate placed in the top of his skull.
